- o part of the attack surface

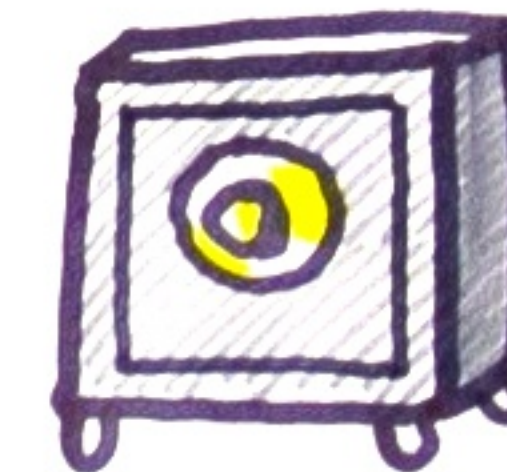

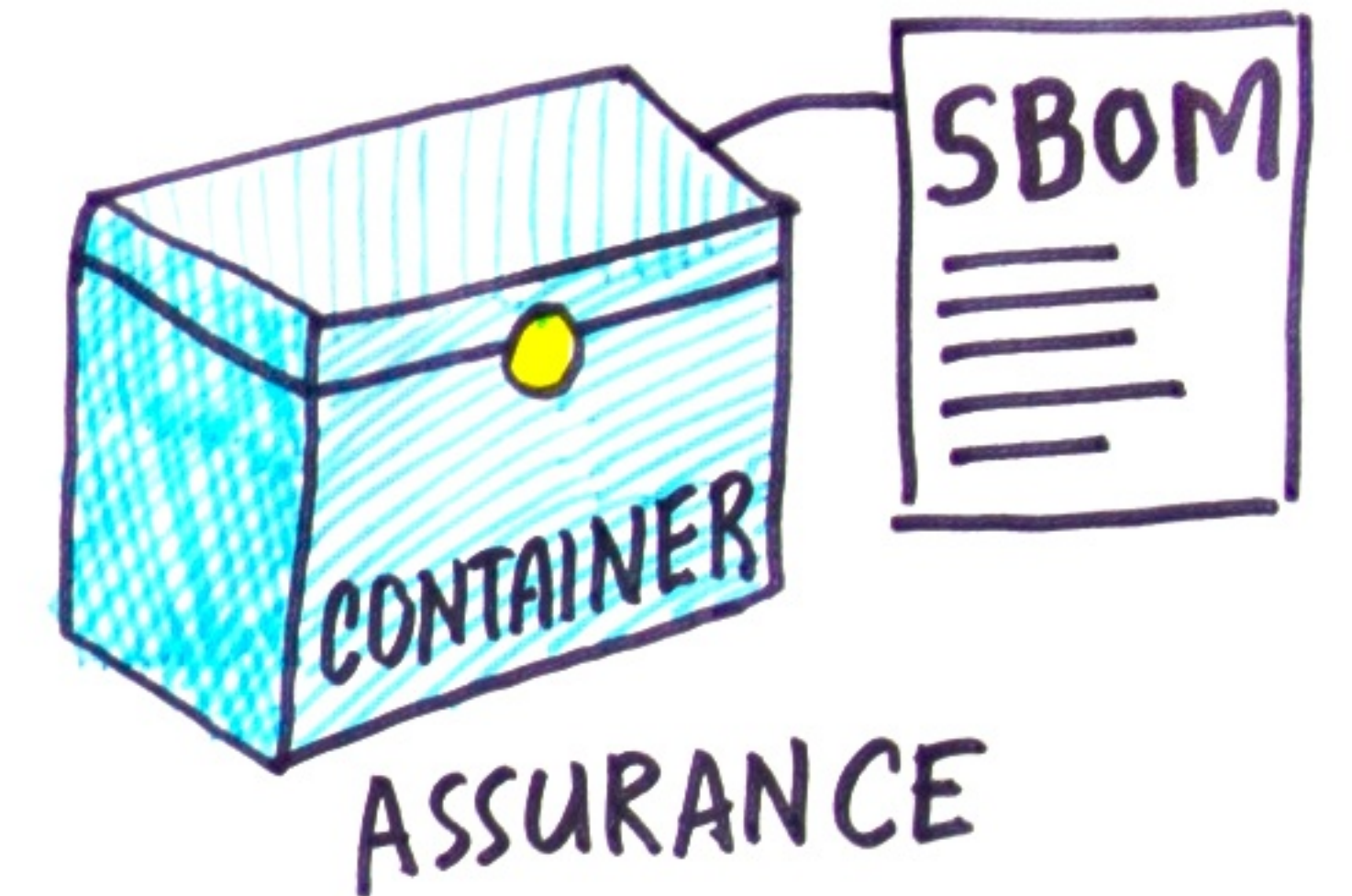
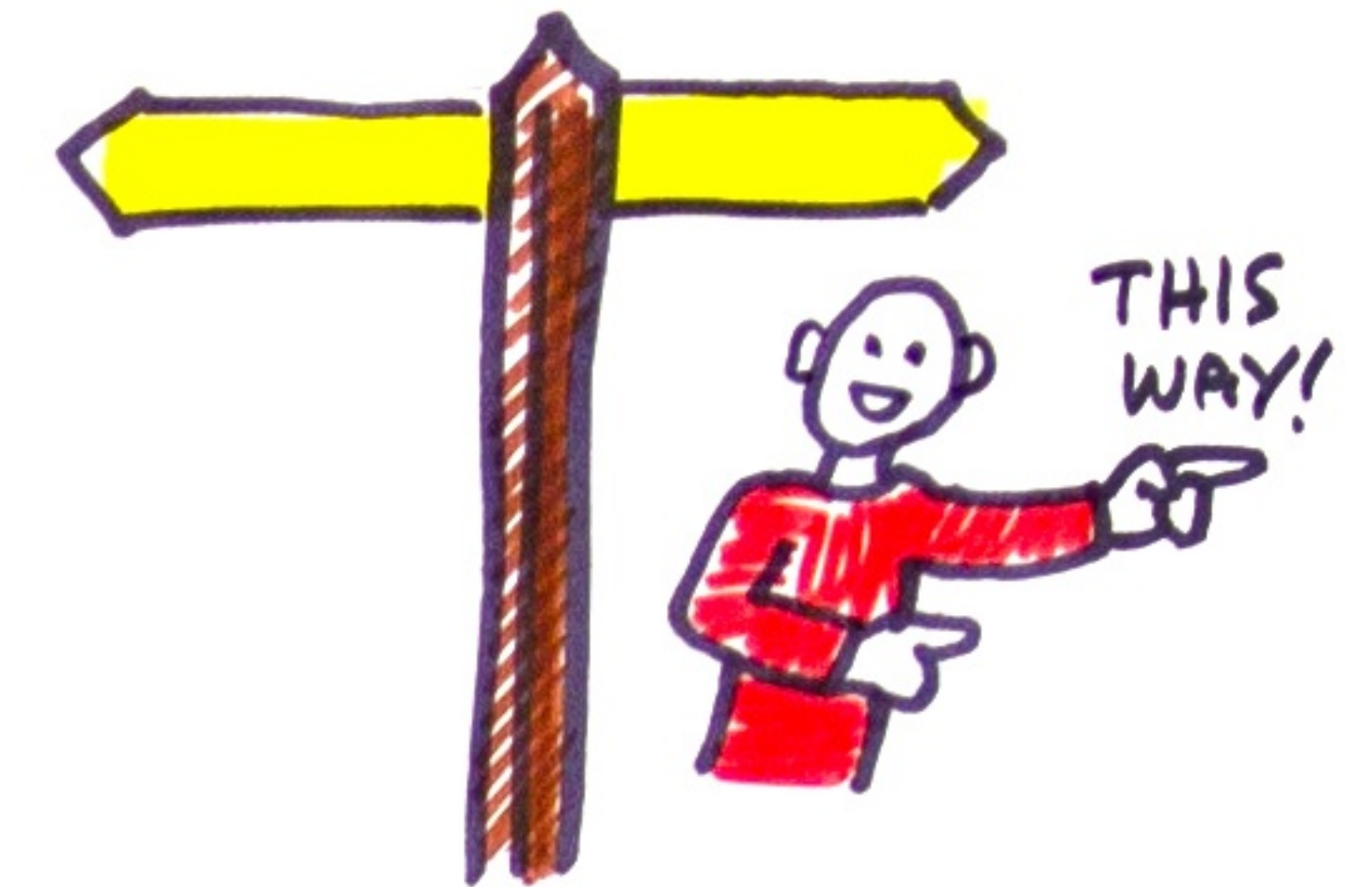
