

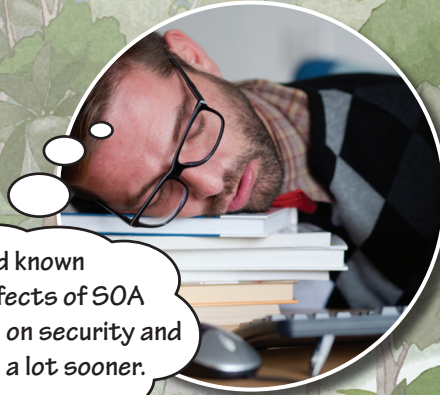
What do you mean that I can't buy SOA out of a box? Isn't it just some infrastructure and service interfaces to our legacy systems?

I wish I'd known about the effects of SOA implementation on security and performance a lot sooner.

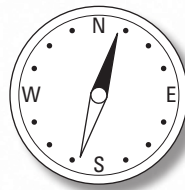


Seems we're altering our SOA adoption goals to match the product we bought. I wish we'd asked smarter questions.
