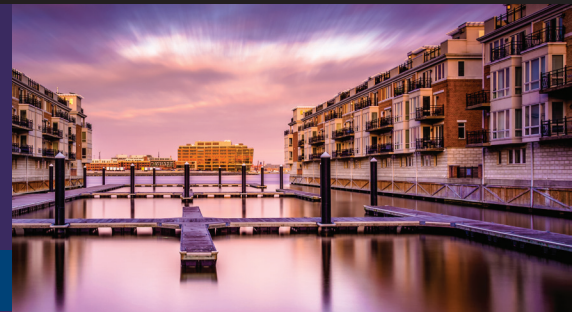

Learning outcomes: Brief description of what attendees will learn and be able to do after attending your talk or session; 3–4 bullet points are usually enough.
